Personal Salvation in the Old Testament

Definitions (what personal salvation consists of)

----- Both Testaments Forgiveness of sins Justification, Sanctification, Glorification Substitution, imputation Promise, Destiny, house of the Lord Election, Predestination, purpose of God, the sake thing Conversation, Change of life, life choices, practical righteousness Relationship, Lordship, adoption, personal savior ----- New Testament Regeneration, indwelling, led by the spirit Intercession, confession before God, advocate, heavenly priest Bride of Christ, the body of Christ, the Church, ----- Some think of personal salvation in terms of magical words (sinner's prayer, thief on the cross), or a spiritual experience (tongues, healing, vision, etc.) or a binding agreement made with God in a decisive moment, in which the sinner claims a promise, which then becomes the essence of personal salvation. But consider salvation as a relationship that begins with the initial encounter, But was actually predetermined and coordinated by God, and is therefore secure. It then is practically identical in both testaments, and indeed could hardly ever be otherwise

Depravity (universal sin, no saving self, works insufficient, necessity of new birth) Heart (inward not outward) Mercy (compassion, forgiveness, etc. not merits) Grace (not works, favor not rooted in efforts, accomplishments, or merit) Faith (not Law, promise about future, hope, expectation)

Believe (person, provision, promise) Repent Confess Follow Come Rest Obey (gospel)

NT claims of OT saved

Considered righteous

Mat 23.35 blood of righteous Abel to Zacharias (Luke 11.51)

(2 Chr 24.20-22 Zechariah son of Jehoiada, Zech 1.1 Berechiah, Isa 8.2 Jeberechiah) Luke 1.5,6 both righteous before God, walking in the commandments and ordinances blameless

Considered Saved

Rom 4.1-5 Abraham justified by faith, not works Heb 11.1-40 good report through faith, Abel, Enoch, Noah, Abram, Isaac, Jacob, Moses, Rahab, Samson, Samuel, David, etc., (v13 these all died in faith, persuaded, embraced, desire heavenly country)

Demonstrations (in OT)

Commitment to and from God

Gen 28.21 then the LORD will be my God Exo 15.2 He is my God, will be my salvation Deu 26.17 avouched the LORD, avouched you 2 Sam 15.8 Absalom vowed to be LORD's servant 2 Kin 5.17 Naaman made LORD his God

Saints (holy people, belonging to God)

Deu 33.2,3 saints in Heaven and on earth 1 Sam 2.9 Hannah 2 Ch 6.41 saints rejoice Job 5.1 Eliphaz Job 15.15 No trust in his saints Psa 16.3, 30.4, 31.23, 97.10, 106.16 (Aaron the saint), 149.5,9, etc. Dan 7.18,21,22,25,27, 8.13 etc. Hos 11.12 Zech 14.5

Calling on his name (Jehovah?)

Gen 4.26 then began men to call upon the name of the LORD Gen 12.8 there he called upon the name of the LORD Gen 13.4, 21.33 Abraham called again Ps 91.14 Because he set his love upon me, I will deliver him, because known my name Ps 116.17 offer thanksgiving and call upon the name of the LORD Isa 52.6 my people shall know my name Joel 2.32 whosoever shall call shall be delivered Zech 13.9 they shall call on my name and I will hear them Mal 4.2 unto you that fear my name shall Sun of r. arise with healing

(Called by his name)

Isa 43.7 every one that is called by my name, created for my glory Isa 63.19 We are thine, they were not called by thy name Jer 14.9 we are called by thy name, leave us not Amos 9.12 all the heathen which are called by my name

Walking with God (or before God)

Gen 5.22 Enoch walked with God Gen 6.9 Noah walked with God 1 Ki 8.23,25 walk before thee with all their heart 2 Chr 6.14 thy servants walk before thee with all their hearts

Being Righteous or Upright (life choices, found throughout compared)

Gen 18.23 wilt thou destroy righteous with wicked Ps 1.5 ungodly shall not stand in congregation of the righteous Pr 2.20 walk in the way of good men, keep paths of righteous

Fearing God (considering judgment) Gen 20.11 surely fear of God not in this place Gen 22.12 now I know thou fearest God Gen 31.42 God of Abraham and fear of Isaac Deu 10.12 God require of thee, to fear LORD, serve with all heart

Worshiping God (exclusively, perfect heart) Gen 22.5 Abraham going to worship Gen 24.63 Isaac meditating in the field 1 Sam 1.3 man went up yearly to worship and sacrifice unto the LORD 1 Ki 8.61 let your heart be perfect with the LORD 1 Ki 15.3 his heart was not perfect 2 Ki 5.17 thy servant will henceforth offer unto other gods, but unto the LORD Knowing God (relationship) Jer 9.6 they refuse to know me, saith the LORD Jer 9.24 glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me Jer 22.16 judged cause of poor, was not this to know me? Jer 24.7 I will give them an heart to know me Jer 31.34 for they all shall know me, I will forgive their iniquity Gal 4.9 after known God, or known of God Tit 1.16 profess they know God

Collective or National Salvation (in OT)

Deu 4.29-31 if thou seek the LORD, thou shalt find him, if with all thy heart Deu 26.18-19 be his peculiar people, holy people, above all nations Deu 30.2-5 shalt return to LORD, have compassion on thee 1 Sam 7.3 If return to LORD, put away strange gods, he will deliver you 1 Ki 8.46-50 hear their prayer, forgive thy people Zech 8.8 they shall dwell in Jerusalem, be my people, be their God Eze 37.23-27 I will save them out of their dwelling places, my tabernacle with them, I will be their God Jer 29.12-14 ye shall find me, with heart, I will gather you Jer 33.15-17 execute righteousness in the land, Judah saved, Jerusalem safely, Lord our righteousness Eze 37.24-25 David king over them, walk in my judgments Hos 3.5 Israel return, seek LORD and David, fear LORD and his goodness in latter days Luke 1.68-75 visited and redeemed his people, raised horn of salvation, saved from enemies Mark 11.10 kingdom of our father David ----- notice a focus on collective sins, how it compares to personal sins and forgiveness Luke 1.77 give knowledge of salvation unto his people by remission of their sins Mat 1.21 he shall save his people from their sins

Gen 4.4 LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering Mat 23.35 blood of righteous Abel (Luke 11.51) Heb 11.4 by faith Abel offered, witness he was righteous, God testifying, even dead 1 Jo 3.12 Abel's works were righteous (Heb 12.24 Jesus' blood speaketh better things than Abel's) Gen 4.3-7 not respect, do well be accepted, if not, sin at the door 1 Jo 3.12 not as Cain, of wicked one, slew brother, works were evil, brother's righteous Jude 11 gone in the way of Cain (works, merit, anger, defiance, hate, despair, stubbornness)

Enoch

Gen 5.24 Enoch walked with God, was not, God took him Heb 11.5 by faith Enoch was translated, testimony that he pleased God Jude 14 Enoch prophesied, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints

Noah

Gen 6.8 Noah found grace Gen 6.9 Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, walked with God Gen 7.1 for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation Gen 7.5 Noah did according unto all the LORD commanded him Gen 8.20 Noah builded an altar, offered burnt offerings Eze 14.14,20 Noah, Daniel and Job, by their righteousness Heb 11.7 by faith Noah condemned world, heir of righteousness by faith 2 Pe 2.5 saved Noah, preacher of righteousness, flood upon ungodly

Melchizedek

Gen 14.18-20 king of Salem, priest of the most high God Ps 110.4 priest after order of Melchizedek Heb 5.6,10; 6.20 priest after order of Melchisedec Heb 7.1-4 Melchisedec, king of righteousness, like Son of God, how great

Terah

Gen 11.31 Terah took Abram and Lot from Ur to Canaan, unto Haran Gen 12.1-8 LORD said to Abram, get thee from kindred, called upon name of LORD Josh 24.2 Your fathers dwelt on other side of flood, Terah, served other gods Josh 24.14 gods your fathers served on the other side of the flood Gen 15.7 LORD brought thee out of Ur Neh 9.7 broughtest him (Abram) out of Ur Eze 16.3 thy father was an Amorite

Abraham

Gen 12.1-8 LORD said to Abram, Get thee from thy kindred, called on name of LORD Gen 13.3,4 went to Bethel, unto altar, there called on the name of the LORD Gen 15.1-6 he believed in the LORD, and he counted it to him for righteousness Gen 17.1 walk before me, be thou perfect Gen 17.23-24 Abraham was 90 years old when he was circumcised Gen 18.17-19 I know him, command children to do justice, LORD bring upon Abraham

John 8.39 if ye were Abraham's children would do the works of Abraham

John 8.56 Abraham rejoiced to see my day, he saw it, and was glad

Rom 4.1-17 Abraham counted righteous by faith, imputation

Gal 3.6-9 they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham

Gal 3.18 God gave it to Abraham by promise

Heb 11.8 by faith Abraham called to go out, obeyed

Heb 11.17 by faith when he was tried offered up only begotten son

Jam 2.21 Abraham justified by works when offered up Isaac

Jam 2.23 scripture fulfilled, Abraham believed God and imputed for righteousness

Lot

Gen 12.4 and Lot went with him

Gen 18.23-25 wilt thou destroy the righteous with the wicked?

Gen 19.16 LORD being merciful unto him

Gen 19.22 I cannot do any thing till thou be come thither

Gen 19.29 God remembered Abraham, and sent Lot out

Deu 2.9,1 I have given it unto the children of Lot for a possession

2 Pe 2.7 delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked

David

Ps 16.11 in thy presence is fullness of joy, right hand pleasures for evermore

Ps 21.4 He asked life, length of days for ever and ever

Ps 23.6 I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever

Ps 65.4 Blessed man whom thou choosest, causest to approach unto thee, satisfied

Ps 17.15 I will behold thy face in righteousness, awake satisfied with thy likeness

Ps 73.24-26 I will behold thy face in righteousness, awake satisfied with thy likeness

Ps 40.4 Blessed man maketh the LORD his trust

Ps 84.12 Blessed the man that trusteth in thee

Ps 85.2 forgiven the iniquity of thy people, covered all their sin

Ps 32.1,2 Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, sin covered

Rom 4.6-8 Blessed whose iniquities forgiven, not impute sin

----- Notice the references by David to his hope, trust and rejoicing in God's righteousness, as if to say David's salvation itself was because of God's righteousness. This was a mystery to Martin Luther, until he understood the concept of imputed righteousness

Ps 7.17 I praise the LORD according to his righteousness

Ps 24.5 he shall receive blessing and righteousness from the God of his salvation

Ps 31.1 In thee do I trust, deliver me in thy righteousness

Ps 35.24 Judge me O LORD according to thy righteousness

Ps 35.28 my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness all the day long

Ps 36.10 continue thy righteousness to the upright in heart

Ps 40.10 I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart, declared thy salvation

Ps 48.10 thy right hand is full of righteousness

Ps 50.6 heavens shall declare his righteousness

Ps 51.15 deliver me from bloodguiltiness O God of my salvation, sing of thy r.

Ps 51.19 pleased with the sacrifices of r.

Ps 69.27 let them not come into thy righteousness

Ps 71.2 Deliver me in thy righteousness

Ps 71.15 My mouth shall shew forth thy righteousness and salvation all the day

Ps 71.16 I will make mention of thy r., even of thine only

Ps 72.1 Give the king thy righteousness

Ps 85.13 R. shall go before him and set us in the way of his steps

Ps 88.12 Shall thy righteousness be known in the land of forgetfulness?

Ps 89.16 In thy righteousness shall they be exalted

Job 22.15-18 marked wicked men, cut down out of time

Job 22.19-30 If return to Almighty, lay up gold as dust, shall deliver the innocent by pureness of hands

Bildad

Job 8.3-4 thy children sinned against him, and he cast them away for their transgression!

Job 8.5-7 if wouldest seek God, make prosperous, greatly increase

Job 8.13-15 all that forget God, perish, house shall not stand

Job 8.20 God will not cast away a perfect man, neither help evil doers Job 18.5-21 light of wicked put out, neither son nor nephew, surely such are the wicked Job 25.4-6 how can man be justified with God, stars not pure, much less man

Zophar

Job 11.3-6 thy lies, my doctrine is pure, exacteth of thee less than thine iniquity deserveth

Job 11.7 Canst thou by searching find out God?

Job 11.14-19 put iniquity far away, thine age clearer than noonday, shalt be secure, rest in safety

Job 11.20 eyes of wicked shall fail, not escape

Job 20.5 triumphing of wicked is short

Job 20.11 bones full of the sin of his youth, which shall lie down with him in the dust

Job 20.23 about to fill his belly, God cast fury of wrath upon him

Job 20.27 heaven shall reveal his iniquity, earth rise up against him

Job 20.29 this is the portion of a wicked man from God

Elihu

Job 33.23-24 if a messenger, interpreter, shew man his uprightness, then gracious, deliver, ransom Job 33.26 for he will render unto man his righteousness

Job 33.27-28 (if repent) will deliver his soul from the pit, life shall see light

Job 34.5-9 Job said I am righteous, what man like Job goeth in company of wicked men

Job 34.10-12 the work of a man shall he render unto him, every man find according to his ways

Job 35.14 judgment is before him, therefore trust thou in him

Job 36.6-7 preserveth not the life of wicked, withdraweth not his eyes from righteous, they are exalted

Job 36.11-12 if they obey they shall spend their days in prosperity, if not, perish by the sword

Job 36.13-14 hypocrites die in youth, life among the unclean

Job 36.15-18 he delivereth the poor, he would have removed thee out of the strait

Job 36.21 iniquity hast thou chosen rather than affliction

Job 36.24-25 remember thou magnify his work, every man may see it, afar off

Job 37.23 the Almighty is excellent in judgment and justice, he will not afflict (the righteous)

Job 1.1 Job perfect and upright, feared God, eschewed evil

Job 1.8 Lord said, considered Job, none like him in the earth

Job 1.21 naked came I of mother's womb, naked return, blessed name of LORD

Job 2.10 speak foolish, receive good from God, not receive evil?

Job 3 (what is life about, why do we just suffer for no reason)

Job 6 (God did this to me, but not for my sin)

Job 7.1-19 (Man's life is not important, why afflict him?)

Job 7.20-21 I sinned, preserver of men, why not pardon my transgression, take away iniquity

Job 9.2 how should man be just with God?

Job 9.13 If God will not withdraw his anger, proud stoop

Job 9.15 though I were righteous, would I not answer, but make supplication

Job.9.19 shall set me a time to plead

Job 9.20 if I justify myself, mine own mouth shall condemn me

Job 9.21 though perfect, would I not know my soul, despise my life

Job 9.22-24 he destroyeth the perfect and the wicked, trial of innocent (no difference?)

Job 9.25-31 thou wilt not hold me innocent, wash with snow, own clothes abhor me

Job 9.32-33 come together (with God) in judgment, no daysman betwixt us

Job 10.2-6 Do not condemn me, seest thou as man that thou searchest after my sin?

Job 10.7 thou knowest that I am not wicked (especially wicked?)

Job 10.15 If wicked, woe unto me, if righteous, yet not lift up, I am full of confusion

Job 10.20 are not my days few, cease then, let me alone, I may take comfort a little

Job 12 (this life is not the reward) v6 tabernacles of robbers prosper, provoke God are secure,

Job 13.15,16 though he slay me, yet will I trust in him, shall be my salvation

Job 13.18 ordered my cause, I know that I shall be justified

Job 13.23 make me know my sins

Job 14.1-4 man is of few days and full of trouble, who bring clean out of unclean

Job 14.5-15 man has one earthly life, dies, and waits for an appointed change

Job 16.17 [afflicted] not for any injustice in my hands, my prayer is pure

Job 16.21 that one might plead for a man with God (intercessor)

Job 17.3 put me in a surety with thee, who will strike hands with me

Job 19.23-27 my redeemer liveth, [after death] I shall behold him

Job 21 (wicked and righteous treated alike, judgment reserved for a future day of wrath v30)

Job 23.3-7 where I might find him, he would put strength in me, delivered from my judge

Job 23.10-14 when tried, shall come forth as gold, performeth thing appointed for me

Job 24 (Why do wicked keep sinning knowing judgment will come, though judgment is delayed) Job 29.14 I put on righteousness

Job 31.24-28 (not) made gold my hope, rejoiced in wealth, secretly enticed by sun or moon, denied God
