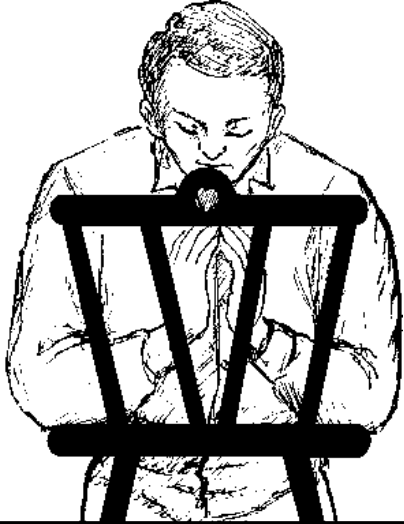

The Bible has declared that Jesus is the last and only effective priest; And that his priesthood will never change. It also states that those that trust directly in Him are forever saved. "And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool. For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified." (Hebrews 10.11-14)



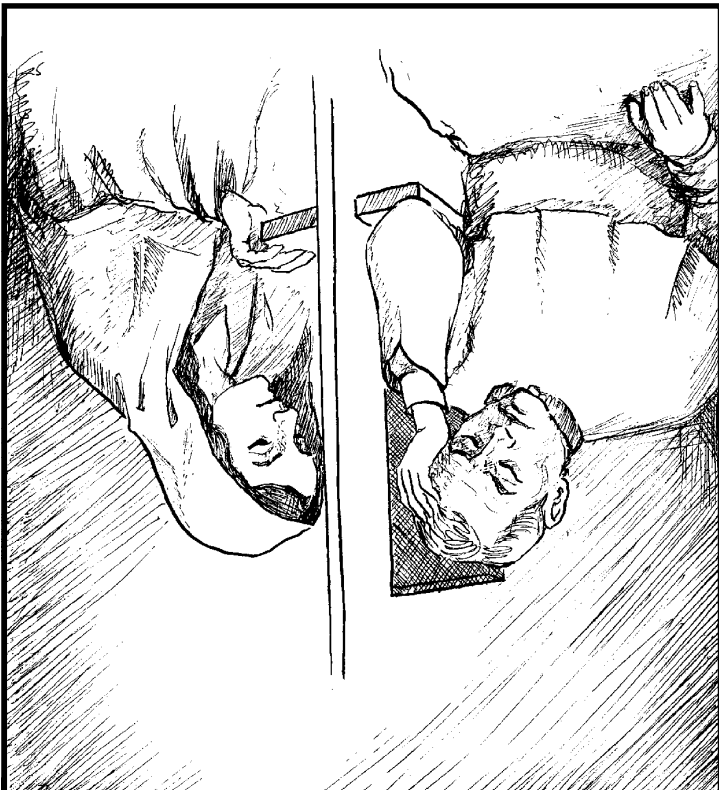

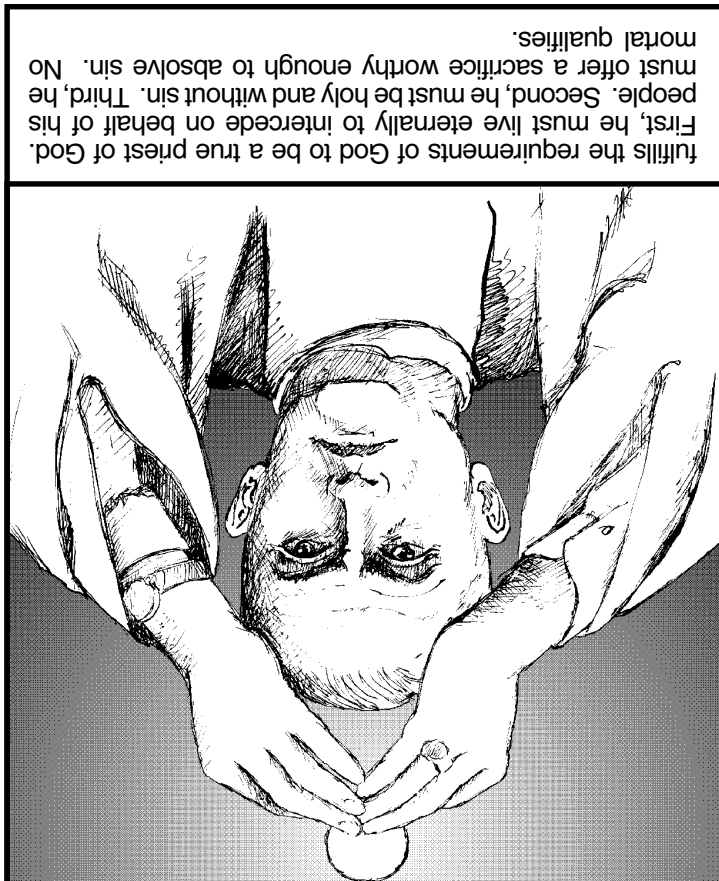
God's Priest



And they truly were many priests, because they were not suffered to continue by reason of death: But this *man*, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. For such an high priest became us, *who is* holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself. (Hebrews 7:23-27)



It so happens that human priests, instead of representing Jesus Christ, replace Christ; Obstructing the intercession of Jesus Christ on behalf of sinners. The Bible declares repeatedly that there is only one mediator between God and man, (1 Timothy 2:5) and that only those that approach God through His intercession receive salvation. Therefore, those that confess their sins to a human priest do not receive forgiveness. However, those that by faith (speaking to Him without seeing Him) accept Jesus as their only priest, are forever saved by his effective intercession. "Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them." (Hebrews 7:25)



Despite these words of the Bible that in decisively show us the vanity of all human priesthood, thousands of men and women still honor men as priests of God. This part of the Bible explains to us why mortal men can never serve as acceptable priests, and why all human priests were replaced by the last true priest of God: Jesus Christ. The book of Hebrews deals with the Jewish priesthood. However, through it we can see that there is not one mortal man that

fulfills the requirements of God to be a true priest of God. First, he must live eternally to intercede on behalf of his people. Second, he must be holy and without sin. Third, he must offer a sacrifice worthy enough to absolve sin. No mortal qualifies.
